IMPORTANT School Council and Knox Council ROAD SAFETY ALERT and REMINDER

It is of **great concern** to local and school community members that a number of parents are consistently breaking basic road laws when *dropping off and picking up* their children, to include

- Leaving cars unattended in the two minute 'drop off' zones in Dobson St & Greenaway Drive – Please note -
Drivers are not permitted to leave their vehicles in the drop off zones between 3.30pm and 3.45pm and 8.30am and 9.15am and may only wait a maximum of 2 minutes before moving on
- Parking too close to corners and driveways
- Parking on the nature strip and grassed areas
- Children crossing the road without using the patrolled crossing
- Accessing the school grounds via the staff car park gates

It is important to note that the Knox Police and Council traffic officers are aware of these unsafe and unlawful practices and randomly patrol our school boundaries.


Our concern is always for the safety of the children and all community members and we ask that drivers abide by the traffic rules and carefully and thoughtfully consider the safety and rights of the school community and the neighbours and their property in Greenaway Drive and Dobson St.

Drop Off Zones

1. Parents are reminded that the car parks painted yellow are basically designated drop off and pick up zones.
2. Parents are also reminded to keep clear of the parking spaces on Greenaway Drive that are designated for disabled community members to gain access to our school.
