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### Program Update

Hi everyone, it is with great pleasure that I announce that I will be staying at Kent Park OSHClub as Program Coordinator. I have enjoyed my time over the last few weeks and am looking forward to even better times ahead. Sarah will remain with the program as well as an assistant, but stepping up to coordinate when I am absent.

Over the last two weeks, the children have been getting involved in a variety of activities, from cooking honey joys, making new playdough, helping build new furniture and creating talent shows to playing tennis, basketball, footy, and also spending some time outside in some of the great weather we have been having.

In the OSHClub room, we have been looking at ways to increase awareness of sustainability. With the children's input, we have commenced recycling the leftover water from the children's cups. The children pour whatever they can't drink into a watering can, which is then used to water the plants inside the room. Over the next few weeks, we will introduce other ways we can recycle.

On Tuesday 29<sup>th</sup> August, Kent Park OSHClub will be going through the Assessment & Ratings process. This process involves us having a visitor from the Department of Education to observe how the service operates within the Law and Regulations and also our guiding framework, the "My Time Our Place", and give an overall score which will either be "Working Towards" or "Meeting" or "Exceeding".
