***** IF YOU HAVE NOT LOGGED ON TO COMPASS AS YET, PLEASE DO SO ASAP.**

Please note that Flexibuzz will be closed down at the end of this term. If you have misplaced your login with your family’s Compass Log In User Name and Password (sent home with your student 2 weeks ago), please contact the office.

In many ways, COMPASS will replace Flexibuzz, to include - Newsfeeds, Absence Approvals and Attendance Data, Excursion and IncurSION Permission and Payments (no paper forms will be required), Parent/Teacher Conference Bookings (which are open now to book your time) and Student Semester Reports.

Class DOJO will remain as a form of communication between parents and teachers.

IT IS IMPORTANT TO UPDATE/ENTER YOUR EMAIL ADDRESS once you have logged in to receive emails about COMPASS notifications/excursion notices etc.. relevant to your child.

If you have misplaced your **previously issued** COMPASS Log In information or have any queries at all, please contact the office asap.
